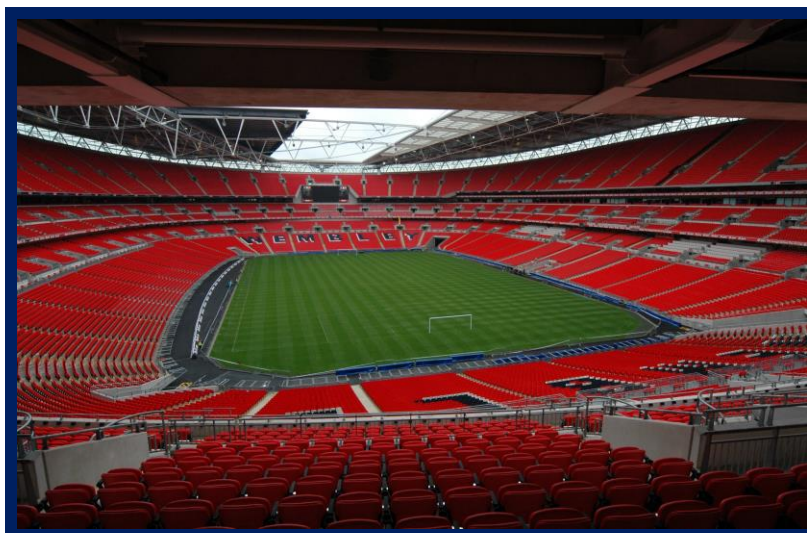


## LONDON, ENGLAND SOCCER TOUR



### Day One

- In the afternoon take a visit to the Tower of London to see the Crown Jewels, Execution Site & more.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening free for social activities.



## Day Five

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Morning practice session.
- Perhaps get out of the city and take a day trip to Stonehenge, Salisbury or Dover.
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening play your second international friendly game vs. an English side.

## Day Six

- Breakfast at hotel.
- This morning, visit the nearby Windsor Castle, the Queen's official residence and the largest inhabited castle in the world. Visitors can enjoy a look around the State Apartments furnished with fine paintings, porcelain, sculpture and armour. Other highlights include Queen Mary's Dolls House and St Georges Chapel, the scene of many royal weddings. The beautiful castle gardens are also worth looking at, part of which were transformed to celebrate the Golden Jubilee.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening free for social activities.

## Day Seven

- Breakfast at hotel.
- This morning, play your third international friendly game vs. an English side.
- This afternoon, possible visit to a professional game (dependent upon schedule).
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening free for social activities.

## Day Eight

- Breakfast at hotel.
- This morning, play your fourth international friendly game vs. an English side.
- Free afternoon for last minute sightseeing in London.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening free to enjoy your last night in England!



## Day Nine

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Depart London Airport on your return flight.
