

Munich Soccer Tour



Day One

- Depart on an overnight flight to Munich Airport.

Day Two

- Arrive at Munich Airport where you are met by your Excel Sports Representative.
- Deluxe coach transfer to your 3* hotel in Munich where you will be staying for the following seven nights.
- Check-in and unpack.
- Welcome meeting and orientation.
- Afternoon free to explore the area.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening training session.

Day Three

- Breakfast at hotel.
- This morning, enjoy a 2-hour walking guided tour of Munich. See some important sights of the city centre including Königsplatz square, Lenbach House, Siegestor gate, Theatiner Church of St. Cajetan, Field Marshals's Hall, Royal Residence, Isartor gate, and Sendlingen Tor gate.
- Free afternoon for lunch and sightseeing on own in Munich.
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening, participate in your first friendly game against a German side.

Day Four

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Morning practice session.
- This afternoon, take a guided tour of the Allianz Arena, which held the 2006 World Cup. It is the home stadium of "Bayern Munich".
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening free for social activities.

Day Five

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Transfer by deluxe coach to Augsburg (approx. an hour journey)
- Free day for sightseeing in Augsburg. See the Town Hall, Perlachturm (a bell tower built in 1182), Dorint Hotel Tower, St. Ulrich and St. Afra, Mozart Haus Augsburg (where Mozart's father was born and Mozart visited several times).
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening play your second international friendly game vs. a German side.

Day Six

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Morning practice session.
- Free afternoon for sightseeing in Munich. Visit the Statue of Bavaria, see the royal antique collection at Glyptothek, or the Schloss Nymphenburg Palace.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening free for social activities.

Day Seven

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Transfer by deluxe coach to Salzburg, Austria (approx. an hour and a half journey).
- Enjoy a day of sightseeing in Salzburg. You can see the Cathedral and St. Peter's Abbey, Hohensalzburg Fortress, Mozart's birthplace, the Festival-Theatres, the oldest pharmacy and the oldest café, Salzach-River, and many other sights.
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening play your third international friendly game vs. a German side.

Day Eight

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Free day to explore and do last minute shopping. Visit the City Center, and the old city walls; visit the Neuhausen and Nymphenburg district, known for its relaxing atmosphere; or visit Thalkirchen and walk along the river Isar.
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening play your fourth international friendly game vs. a German side.

Day Nine

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Depart Munich Airport on your return flight.

ABOUT GERMANY

Munich - Munich is the largest city in the south of Germany, about an hour and a half drive from the Alps and close to Austria, Italy and Switzerland. Like many ancient cities, Munich started as a small town enclosed by a city wall, and over the years expanded out past the wall. The 'inner city' occupies this small area where many sites are close and easy to visit. You will get a sense of the ancient walls, the gates still remain. The city is a haven for all sorts of culture, with a staggering array of museums, a vibrant arts scene and the infamous revels of Oktoberfest. Sights to see in Munich: Frauenkirche, the Steeple of Town Hall, Residenz Palace, Viktualienmarkt, the Olympic Park, Nymphenburg Palace and Gardens, Deutsches Museum, Alter Peter, Asamkirche, Allianz Arena and much more.
