

CZECH REPUBLIC SOCCER TOUR



Day One

- Depart on an overnight flight to Prague Airport.

Day Two

- Arrive at Prague Airport, where you are met by your Excel Sports Representative.
- Transfer by deluxe coach to your 3* hotel in Prague, where you will be staying for the following seven nights.
- Welcome meeting and orientation.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening training session.

Day Three

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Enjoy a 2-hour walking tour of Prague - This walking tour starts on the boundary of the Old Town and the New Town - The Powder Gate at The Republiky Square which is the entrance to the Royal Route. After walking through the Celetna Street we reach the Old Town Square with its famous astronomical clocks which has always been the witness of gatherings of people. Continuing into the Jewish quarter you will view the last remnants of rich Jewish history. The tour ends on the Charles Bridge where you can admire the open gallery of sculptures.
- Afternoon free for sightseeing and lunch on own.
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening, play your first international friendly game vs. a local side.

Day Four

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Light training session in the morning.
- Afternoon sightseeing, visit to the Prague Castle – enter the stone heritage of a millennium of history. Standing on the ramp of Prague Castle and watching the city lying below you will understand why this complex of secular and sacral buildings has remained the centre of the Czech state and church power since the time of its origin.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening free for social activities.

Day Five

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Depart on deluxe coach to Jablonec nad Nisou.
- Sightseeing in Jablonec nad Nisou – a center of glass and jewelry production. It is well known for its modern architecture; visit the New Town Hall, the baroque Church of St Anne, the Town Theatre and the Museum of Glass and Jewelry. Jablonec nad Nisou was founded in the 14th century, the first written mention of the town was in 1356, there is a lot of history to be discovered here.
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening, play your second international friendly game vs. a local side.

Day Six

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Morning practice session.
- Free time for sightseeing in Prague on own. Sights to see in Prague: Basilica and Convent of St. George, Bertramka Villa, Troja Botanical Gardens, Black Tower at Prague Castle, The House of the Black Madonna, House at the Stone Bell, Church of St. Nicholas in Mala Strana, Jindriska Tower, Kampa Island, Charles Bridge, Cathedral of SS Vitus, Wenceslas and Adalbert, Loreta, Neudova Street, Prague Castle, the Astronomical Clock, Petrin Tower, Powder Tower, Troja Chateau and much more!
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening free for social activities.

Day Seven

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Depart on deluxe coach to Karlstejn.
- Afternoon visit to Karlstejn Castle - exceptional even among the Czech castles, not only for its historical significance but also due to its robustness and architecture. It was established by the Czech and Roman King Karel IV in 1348, who gave it the role of the treasury for the coronation insignia and the most valuable relics of the Holy Roman Empire.
- Dinner at hotel.
- This evening, participate in your third international friendly game vs. a local side.

Day Eight

- Breakfast at hotel.
- This morning participate in your fourth international friendly game vs. a local side.
- Free afternoon for last minute sightseeing and shopping in Prague.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Evening free for social activities.

Day Nine

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Transfer by deluxe coach to Prague Airport for your return flight home.
